### **Learn About Diesel Engine Troubleshooting Nov. 27-29 in Seattle**

Washington Sea Grant and the Port of Seattle/Fishermen's Terminal are co-sponsoring a three-evening Diesel Engine Troubleshooting and Maintenance Workshop, Nov. 27-29 in Seattle.

Designed for commercial fishermen and recreational boaters, workshop sessions will be held 6:30-9:30 each evening on Nov. 27, 28 and 29 at the Nordby Conference Center, Nordby Building, Fishermen's Terminal.

The workshop will include an overview of troubleshooting and maintenance and focus on fuel, lubrication, electrical, cooling and exhaust systems.
