### **Washington Sea Grant Offers First Aid at Sea Course**

Washington Sea Grant and the Port of Seattle Fishermen's Terminal are co-sponsoring a U.S. Coast Guard-approved First Aid at Sea course on June 12, 2008, 8 a.m.-4 p.m., in the Nordby Conference Room, Nordby Building, at Fishermen's Terminal in Seattle.

This one-day course is designed for commercial fishermen and recreational boaters. Topics will include cardio-pulmonary resuscitation, patient assessment, shock, trauma, burns, fractures, hypothermia, cold-water near-drowning, immobilization, backboards, first-aid kits, and more.

The fee for the workshop is \$80. Space is limited, so pre-registration is advised.
