








- 1. Start with a water plan (not a land plan)
  - Do an inventory of water-borne tenants
  - Understand their business of growth opportunities
  - Analyze the berthing opportunities and in-water space
  - Optimize the adjacency and/or location of uses
  - Create more water if necessary






- 2. Integrate with and enhance what already exists

  - Chart a path forward that includes existing successful stakeholders
  - Include as much diversity as possible




#### 3. Emphasize the public environment
