#### Friday, Sept. 30 afternoon & evening – FisherPoets-in-Bellingham

Stroll through downtown Bellingham and listen to old salts – local fishers accustomed to mending and hauling nets, instead plucking guitar strings and adjusting their spectacles to read poems, stories, and songs in the 1st Annual **FisherPoets-in-Bellingham**. In this take-off on the renowned FisherPoets Gathering in Astoria, Ore., FisherPoets-in-Bellingham promises to produce smiles and laughter as fishers share their tales over local ales (brewed right in the setting). A popular local dance band will follow into the night.

## Saturday, Oct. 1 all day & evening

- Witness the first International Salmon Barbecue Contest where professionals and amateurs compete for prizes by grilling their salmon for presentation to celebrity chef judges.
- Commercial Fishing Activities in the working harbor of Bellingham Bay:
  - Meet-the-Fishers opportunities include Boat Tours, Dock Walks, visits with Celebrity Fishers.
  - Cheer as fishers & friends compete in Survival Suit Demos & Races.
  - Try your hand at **Knot-Tying and Net-Mending** after watching Demos from the Pros.
  - Learn from local professionals how to fillet and prepare our delicious Salish Sea seafood, and watch fish-filleting, crabcracking, and oyster shucking demonstrations.
  - Enjoy the melt-in-your-mouth delicacies of salmon grilled in the traditional Native American, open-pit manner prepared by members of nearby Lummi Nation. Also, taste other seafood and locally-grown produce.
  - Cooking Demonstrations learn easy, family-friendly ways to prepare our local seafood for healthy meals.
  - Try your skill at the Grab-a-Crab Tank Derby and watch the Oyster Shucking Contest.
- Board a certified tour passenger vessel and ride across the Bay to Bellingham Cold Storage for a tour of the largest food-processing & storage facility on the West Coast, situated in the heart of the Port of Bellingham.
- Brews-with-a-View enjoy beer, ale, and hard ciders while watching the waves lap at your feet.
- Participate in family-friendly, hands-on educational and fun activities to learn about the key connections between our healthy waters, healthy seafood, and a healthy YOU.
- Appreciate arts displays and sales from juried artists throughout the Great Northwest.
- Enjoy live music at its best, featuring popular regional bands on stages set against the backdrop of our Salish Sea.
