Learn Sea Survival Skills in Gig Harbor

Be prepared at sea - receive training for emergency drills and more.

What: Washington Sea Grant and the Gig Harbor Boat Shop are co-sponsoring a Coast Guard Approved Drill Instructor course for commercial fisherman and charter boat operators on Wednesday, March 18, 2015.

This Coast Guard-approved course meets the training requirements of the Commercial Fishing Safety Act to conduct drills. Course work combines lecture and hands-on experience with safety and survival equipment required for commercial fishing vessels.
